



The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents, that I John Anderson of the State aforesaid and district of Greenville for the sum of one hundred Dollars paid by Luke Ray of the said State and district, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release to the said Luke Ray his heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land in the district and State above mentioned, on horse creek of Reedy River Beginning on the said horse creek on a gum bush st near a spring thence up the said creek with its meanders to a maple st being about 24 chains thence S.W. 50: 21 Chain touches nut bush on flayborn Sullivants line thence S.E. 25: 24 ch. to a Red oak st on Hudson Berrys line thence N.E. 50: 21 chain to the Beginning. supposed to contain fifty acres be the same more or less.

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To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ray forever, Together with the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to them belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. And I as hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant and forever defend the said
