 Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the s^r. Hudson Berry a plantation and tract of land
 in the district aforesaid, on the s^e. side of Reedy River being part of a tract originally
 granted to Daniel Huger the 15th day of October 1784. Recorded in grant book N^o. 111
 page 190. then conveyed to round to s^r. Pulling now from s^r. Paulding to s^r. Perry part
 of the tract. Beginning on a stake joining Townsends & Polings Land, running thence s⁷⁴
 E. 19^o 00 to a post oak, thence s^o 60 E. 28 ch. to a post oak, thence N. 15 E 29 ch. to a white
 oak, thence N. 20 E. 8 ch. to a stake on the River, thence up said River its mean and
 a red oak on the bank, thence s^o 54 W. 38^o 50 to a post oak, thence N. W. 18 ch. to a red
 oak, thence s^o 65 W. 12 ch. to a stake, thence s^o 36 E 25 to the Beginning, all in these
 bounds for one hundred and ninety acres Together with all and singular the
 rights, members, incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have & To hold all and singular the
 premises before mentioned unto the said Hudson Berry his heirs and assigns forever,
 And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Hudson Berry
 his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and
 seal this sixth day of Oct. 1801. and in the twenty sixth year of the Independence
