South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Stephen Langford of Tennessee in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Enoch Pruton of South Carolina & Greenville district have granted bargained and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Enoch Pruton all that tract of land being in the district of Greenville on South Tigr river, beginning on a white oak on a Conditional line made between Robert Nelson and Martha Langford, running thence North 50 ft. to a Stone Corner, thence S 55 W. 26 to a White oak thence W. 26 ch. to a White Oak, thence S. 40 W. 106 ch. to a Pine thence S. 50 E. to a poplar on the Conditional line, on a branch thence down the meander, of S. March to the river and then along the Conditional line to the beginning corner, containing One hundred and fifty acres, by estimation, be the same more or less. The same being part of a tract of land granted to Robert Nelson - Together with all & singular the rights members hereunto and appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Enoch Pruton his heirs and assigns for ever, & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Enoch Pruton his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons
