


The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents, that Whereas <sup>167</sup> Gittat  
Sweet did on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1800, convey to Adam Garruth and  
Lemuel J. Alston a tract of Land <sup>to pay</sup> containing two hundred and thirteen  
acres being part of a tract of three hundred and thirteen acres originally  
granted to David R. Evans, and by him conveyed to John Goodwin and by  
Goodwin conveyed to said Sweet. Now know ye that I the said Lemuel  
J. Alston do hereby relinquish and release all my right, title interest  
and claim to the said the said two hundred and thirteen acres of Land unto  
Adam Garruth of the district & State aforesaid — and do also warrant and  
defend the same against myself and my heirs, or any person claiming  
under me — Witness my hand and seal this 17<sup>th</sup> day of February in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen

Brown for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to me in hand  
paid by John Whitten, both of us of the State and district aforesaid, have granted  
bargained sold and released unto said Whitten a certain parcel or quantity of  
land lying & being in the State and district aforesaid, lying on both sides of S. Sacote  
the first being part of a tract of land granted to Samuel Earley, by Patent bearing date  
the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of January 1785 & from him conveyed to me beginning at a black Oak  
marked M. E. running thence N 47<sup>o</sup> 40<sup>st</sup> 75<sup>o</sup> to a Stake, thence S. W. 17<sup>o</sup> 42<sup>o</sup>  
to a P. Ok — thence S. 47<sup>o</sup> E. 35<sup>o</sup> to a W. Ok "marked M. E." thence a Conditional line  
to the beginning corner supposed to contain one hundred and fifty acres, be the  
same more or less, One other parcel of land, adjoining the above granted to
