Williams All that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid, containing forty acres be the same more or less, beginning on a red oak corner Conditionally made between Ambrose Blackburn and Levi Salyer Esq. on George Goodwin's old line, thence along a conditional line to a red oak corner from thence to John Clements, Post Oak Corner, from thence along said Clements line to said Goodwin, Staked Corner, from thence along said Goodwin line to a Poplar Corner, from thence along said Goodwin line to the beginning Corner - To have and to hold the before mentioned premises with the appurtenances to the said Thomas B. Williams his heirs, & assigns forever - And I do hereby warrant and forever will defend the before mentioned premises to the said Thomas B. Williams his heirs and assigns, against me & my heirs, and against the claims or claims of all person or persons, whomsoever.
