that I William Harbin of the State and district aforesaid in and for the consideration of sixty  
Dollars in hand paid by Abner Smith, Have bargained sold and released and by these  
presents have bargained sold, & released unto the said Abner Smith his heirs and assigns  
a certain tract of land containing fifty five acres more or less, lying within  
the bounds on such marked trees as followeth, Beginning at a live wood stake on  
Benjamin Smiths line going Easterly to a corner partly north to a post oak from thence  
partly East to a red oak from thence partly North to live wood stake from thence  
along the conditional line to the Beginning corner, To have & To hold the s<sup>d</sup> premises  
together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances  
to the premises, belonging or in any wise incident, To have & To hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Abner Smith or to his heirs and  
assigns, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & Administrators, Assigns,  
and do warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the s<sup>d</sup>  
Abner Smith his heirs and assigns, & against myself and my heirs, Assigns, and  
against every other person or persons, whatsover Lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof. As Witness my hand and seal this day and date
