Brown for and in consideration of the affection and respect I bear unto Peter Sullivan, who married my daughter Elmira, do grant sell bargain and release and by these presents do grant & give unto the said Peter a certain tract or parcel of land whereon he is now living originally granted unto Duncan Campbell David Hall and Richard Brasill being part of those tracts reference being had unto their grants & a title made unto me will make this release more fully appear from Adam Sloan. Beginning at a stake where John Whittens line crosses the line run for & surveyed for Richard Brasill thence with his line to the mouth of a branch known by the Rock house branch thence with the meanders of the branch to the head thereof thence with John Whittens line unto a stake on Robert Goodgion, line thence N. 70 W. to a chestnut thence S. 45 W. W. 10 chains to a small chestnut thence W. 10 chains to a hickory thence N. 15 W. 25 chains to a red oak near the head of a branch thence with the meanders of the same to Green creek where one other branch empties in on the West side or N. side thence with the meanders thereof with the right hand fork unto the line run for Richard Brasill before mentioned, containing three hundred acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaries and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to have & to hold the above mentioned premises, forever and I the said Willey for me & my heirs, Exors or assigns do hereby warrant and defend the same unto the said Peter his heirs or assigns against any person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
