State of South Carolina Greenville District I know all men by these presents that I John Sparks of the state aforesaid and district of Greenville in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by Young Griffin of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Released unto the said Young Griffin a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less beginning at a large stopping hickory thence along the original line to the corner thence North to the corner of said land thence N. E. along the oak line to a chestnut Stake thence a straight line to the said hickory together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Young Griffin his heirs or assigns forever and I do here by bind myself my heirs and my executors administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Young Griffin his heirs and assigns against my heirs or against any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim any part thereof as witness my hand this 6<sup>th</sup> of August 1801 and in the thirty fifth year independency of the United States of America.
