E. 21. 14 to a stake, thence S 23. W. 15. 78. to a post oak, thence S. 79. W. 13. 00 to a sweet Gum, thence N. 27. W. 5. 50. to a sweet Gum on the left Branch, thence ~~of the~~ said Branch with the meanders of the same to the beginning — Together with all & singular the rights & manors hereditaments & appurtenances to said Land & premises, to have and to hold all & singular, to the said Land & premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew Bridges his heirs & assigns forever — And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said Land and premises before mentioned to the said Andrew Bridges his heirs &c — against myself my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of May one thousand Eight Hundred & fourteen — signed seal & delivered in presence of Test.
