B. B. page 230 bearing date the 7th day of May 1785 - the other part not known who it was granted to - beginning on a ~~place~~ on the north side bank of Soluda river, thence running N. 78. E 43. 50 to a Stake, thence N 14 E. 29. 0. to a Spanish Oak, thence N. 73 W. 11. 30 to a black oak, thence N. 10 W. 17. 0. to a Pine, thence S. 75 W. 48. 50 to a post oak, thence N. 48 W. 11. 0. to a black oak, thence S. 65 W. 9. 0 to a rock in the river near a Shoal, thence down the meander of the river to the beginning including the Plan. tation that Isaac Jordan now lives on, containing two hundred & twenty five acres of land by estimation, to the same more or less.
