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This Indenture made this eighth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between James Chasteen of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part, and Harris Mullens of the said State and County of the other part. Witness it be that for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds sterling money in hand paid by the said Harris Mullens, the receipt whereof he the said James Chasteen doth hereby acknowledge he hath bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Harris Mullens his heirs & assigns forever, all that plantation or tract of land containing fifty acres more or less, Situate lying and being in Greenville County on the north side of Little Horse Creek, bounded on the S. side by Henry Burrows line, and on the W. by Jacob Nabour line, and on the N. by Huges line, and on the E. by Harris Mullens line, being part of a tract of land granted to William Story, and conveyed to the said James Chasteen, reference being thereunto had may more fully appear, and also all the land trees timber trees, woods, undewood by the commons of pasture, ways, water, and water courses and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rights and services of the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, and all the estate rights and titles, Interest, claims and demands whatsoever of him the said James Chasteen of in & to the said premises and every part thereof; To have and to hold the S. Tract of fifty acres of Land, more or less; and all and singular the premises above mentioned, and every part thereof, with the appurtenances unto the said Harris Mullens his heirs and assigns forever, and the S. James Chasteen for himself and his heirs the said tract of Land and premises and every part thereof, against him and his heirs & assigns, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever with warrant and force defend to the S.
