Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Sperein of Laurens district in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Benjamin Arnold of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Benjamin Arnold all that Plantation or tract of land containing fifty acres, more or less situate lying and being in Greenville district on Little Horse Creek bounded on the South side by Henry Burrows Land on the west side by Jacob Stabor's land, on the North side by Hagers Survey on the East by Benjamin Arnolds Land (the present purchaser) being part of a tract of land originally granted to William Story & conveyed by said Story to James Chestain and conveyed by said Chestain to Harris Mullens & conveyed by said Mullens to John Loochefs and conveyed by said Loochefs to James Taylor, reference being thereunto had it may more fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hindertments, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Arnold his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Arnold his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 29th of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fourteen and in the twenty ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
