Originally granted to Paul Fountain, bearing date the 4th day of July 1785, & conveyed to Robert Cannon, from Robert Cannon to Robert Harrison, from Robert Harrison to Vincent Harrison, from Vincent Harrison to me lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of Saluda river, and "having" such form and marks, as by a plat doth represent, beginning on a Hickory N: 50 E to a Post oak S: 18 E to a red oak, thence S: 55 to a Pine, thence S 83 E to an ash, thence to a red oak a Conditional Corner, thence on a Conditional line to a red oak, thence to a red oak, thence to a Peach tree Corner thence to a red oak, thence on the conditional to a red oak on the river, thence the meanders of the river to the beginning, to contain sixty five acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances, to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to warrant & forever defend the said premises, unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or person, whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and in the thirty ninth year of American Independence (turn over)
