

Know all men by these Presents that I George Poque of State & District aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of five hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Fleming Thomason of the State & District aforesaid have granted bargained & released, and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release to the said Fleming Thomason, four hundred and twenty one acres of land more or less, Together with all & singular therein mentioned, the said being on the waters of Bakers Fork. Beginning on a Post Oak Corner, thence running S 26 W. 55 ch. & 30 links to Pine Corner, thence running N 19 W. 23 ch. to a Black Oak Corner, thence running S 76 W. 17 Ch. to a Pine stump Corner, thence running N. 34 W. 41 chains, 80 link, to a Stake corner, thence running S 60 E. 11 1/2 chains, 50 link, to a Stake corner, thence running N. 26 E 99 ch. 75 links, to Pine corner, thence running N. 60 E 43 chains, to Stake corner, thence running S 62 E. 51 ch. 50 links, to a Post oak corner, thence running N. 61 E. 17 chains, 15 links, to a black oak, thence running S 23 W. 16 ch. to a hickory corner, thence running S 40 W. 41 chains, to a Post oak corner, thence running N. 60 W. 44 ch. 50 links to the beginning corner, containing four hundred and twenty one acres, of land more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Fleming Thomason his heirs, & assigns forever. & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular above mentioned unto the said Fleming Thomason his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, & assigns, & all & every other person whatsoever, in witness whereof, I do hereunto set my hand & seal this 16th day of March one thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these Presents that I John Jones of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by Silas Holloway of the district and State aforesaid, have granted bargained & sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Silas Holloway all that Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district & State aforesaid, on the waters of Saluda river, or rather, the Golden Grove creek - Beginning at a Stake on Jeremiah Clewlands line, thence S 45 W 35 chains, on said Holloways line to Jones' Corner on a Black Oak, thence N. 48 W. 43 Chains, along Jones' line to a Black Oak, thence N. 45 E 40 chains, on the Widow Somerlin or Sawell line to Jeremiah Clewlands line on a Stake, thence along Jeremiah Clewlands line to the beginning, Containing one hundred acres more or less; Together with all
