






403. State of South Carolina I George Grace one of the Justices of the Quorum do hereby Certify to all whom it may concern, that Rhody Lee wife of the within named William Lee did this day appear before me, and upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that she doth freely & voluntarily, and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release and forever relinquish unto the within named James Holland his heirs and assigns all his interest and Estate, and also all his right & claim of Dower of in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned and released. Given under my hand this first day of April 1806 —

South Carolina Greenville District. Personally came Obadiash Estes before me & made oath that he saw William Lee sign seal and deliver the within deed of Conveyance to the within named James Holland for the use and purpose therein mentioned; and that Joseph Coker was a subscribing Witness with himself at the same time. Know all men by these presents that I Henry Geddes of the District of Charleston in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars to me paid by Colonel William Austin of Greenville District in the same State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold & Released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and Release unto the said Colonel William Austin all that plantation or tract of Land in the District formerly called Ninety Six now called Greenville District, situated lying and being on a small branch of Guilden Creek cutting and bounding in Churchill Jacksons land and John Pecks land, and hath such cutting marks and Boundings as the above plat represents and which said Plantation or tract of Land contains about two hundred acres more or less. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Colonel William Austin his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Colonel William Austin his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
