The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Harrison sen. of the district of Greenville and state aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Ezekiel Vincent of the district of Greenville and state aforesaid Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Ezekiel Vincent all that part of a certain tract or parcel of land Originally granted to him the said James Harrison and acquired by Governor Moultrie on the second day of December 1793 lying and being in the district aforesaid and on the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda River all that part of said tract Beginning on a white oak station near a branch on a line originally surveyed for Miles Jennings from thence West till it shall intersect with the original line of the said Original grant thence S.E. 10° on the original line to a Stake corner on a line originally made for William Reed thence S.E. 70° on the said line to a post oak corner thence N.W. 50° 20 chains to a corner thence N.E. 30° fifteen chains to a white oak corner thence
