Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Lemuel Sarr, Abitor of the State aforesaid in the district of Greenville in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to me in hand paid by the Hon^{ble} Waddy Thompson Esq. of said district, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Waddy Thompson Esq. all that parcel of tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less, lying & being in the district aforesaid on both sides of Richland Creek of Paddy River, Beginning at a red oak running thence S. 45 E. 50 chains to a red oak, thence S. 45 W. 40 Chs. to a red oak, thence N. 45 W. 50 Chs. to a stake & from thence N. 45 E. 40 chains to the beginning, together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or of appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Waddy Thompson Esq. his heirs and assigns forever fully warranting and forever defending the same against myself and my heirs but no further - as hereby expressed and fully intended agreeable to the contract of the parties, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 12th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & fifteen and in the thirty ninth & fortieth of American Independance, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year above written.
