State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Shadrach Golly <sup>443</sup> of Spartanburg district and State aforesaid in consideration of six hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by George Green of Greenville district in the State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George Green all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville district and in the State aforesaid, on both sides of Hampton branch waters of South Tyger River originally granted unto Josiah Cutbertson on the sixteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four by his excellency Benjamin Guward containing two hundred acres and bounded as follows Beginning on a post oak corner running from thence East forty four chains seventy two links to a black oak corner thence South forty four chain seventy two links to a post oak corner thence West forty four chain seventy two links to a stake corner thence North forty four chain seventy two links to the beginning corner with reference to the original plat which will make it more fully appear also one other tract or parcel of land containing thirty six acres being part of two tracts of land one granted to John Thomas the other to Joseph O'Bannon and adjoining the above described land and bounded as follows beginning on a stake corner on the bank of South Tyger River and running from thence North fifty five East five chain to a red oak corner thence North twenty five chain to a post oak corner thence West fifteen chain to a Hickory corner thence South twelve West thirteen chain seventy five links to a maple on the edge of a swamp thence following the meanders of the swamp to an ash corner on the bank of the river thence down the meanders of the River to the Beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members here dements and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Green his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George Green his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
