Benson Collector of District N^o 13. the same I do warrant and defend from myself my heirs and from all persons claiming under me or them and from no other person unto the said Francis Macken and his heirs forever. Witness my hand and seal this 11th day of November one thousand Eight hundred and fifteen "Entwine the words - fifty acres" signed sealed in the presence of James K. Benson. Willis Benson.

462 This Indenture made this fifteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety and of the Independance of the United States of America the fifteenth becom Joseph Woodall of the County of Pendleton and State of South Carolina of the one part and Samuel Walker of the State aforesaid and County of Greenville of the other part Witnesseth that whereas by a certain grant bearing date the seventh day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighty five from under the hand of his excellency William Moultrie Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the said State at Charleston and for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto the said Joseph Woodall a plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres situate in the district of Ninety six on Rocky Creek waters of Evora which grant being duly Recorded in the Secretaries office grant book S. P. P. page 318 Reference being therunto had may more fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Joseph Woodall for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five pounds Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Samuel Walker at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt the said Joseph Woodall doth hereby acknowledge he the said Joseph Woodall hath granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Samuel Walker his heirs & assigns forever the above mentioned plantation or tract of land together with all trees wood underwood tithes Common Common of pasture profits Commodities advantages hereditaments ways waters and appurtenances whatsoever to the
