bearing date the 26th day of February 1800. it being duly recorded in the
Clerks Office and by the said Munson sold & conveyed to the said Wm. Few,
To Have & To Hold all and singular the above mentioned to the said
David Jackson his heirs and assigns forever and I the said William Few
for myself and my heirs Executors and administrators unto the said David
