sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
Release unto the said West a certain tract or parcel of land contain-  
ing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, situated  
in the State and district aforesaid on the north side of Bushy Creek  
waters of Roedy River. Beginning at the mouth of a branch running  
into Bushy Creek which branch is the dividing line between the  
s<sup>t</sup>. Land and William Ayres Land, thence up said branch to a Red  
oak corner, near the head of said branch thence nearly a N. & E.  
course to a pine corner on Wadsworths line thence along said  
line S. to the aforesaid bushy creek and thence said creek to be  
whereon the said West now lives. Together with all and single  
bar the land before mentioned, and of the said Bolding do  
bind myself my heirs, Exors. admors. and assigns to warrant and  
forever defend the said premises together with all & singular  
the Rights, hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said  
West his heirs, Exors. admors. &c. against myself, my heirs, Exors.  
admors. and assigns and against every other person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
