live lying and being situated in Greenville district on the waters of
Lawfel Creek it being a tract of land whereon Dr. Shelton lived.
Beginning on John Goodwin thence by John Stokes line thence by
Johny Feaborn line thence by William Wilson line thence by the widow
Shelton line thence to the beginning corner on John Stokes line including
two hundred acres more or less - Together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said H. Griffin his heirs and assigns, and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said H. Griffin
his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs or assigns and against
any other person or persons whomsoever shall lawfully claim the
same or any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 16th Oct. 1808. signed, sealed and delivered
