The State of south Carolina; Know all men by these presents that I William  
 Harbin of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in Consideration  
 of the sum of one Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin  
 Smith of the district and state aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and  
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
 Benjamin Smith a plantation or tract of land estimated at two hundred acres  
 be the same or best less situate lying and being in the District and state aforesaid  
 being part of a tract of Land originally granted to Nathaniel Walker and con-  
 veyed to said Harbin lying on both sides of Rock Creek & the muddy Branch  
 waters of Enore river Beginning on a Spanish oak corner running thence  
 S 63 W 40 Chains to a pine stump thence N 19 W 61 ch to a black oak
