Moultrie Esq. on the 10th day of September 1796 beginning on a Stake running S.W. on old Elroy's & Pennell's line to a marked road to Gillams line thence N.E. to a post oak corner thence N.W. 89. 6. to a post oak on Lewis Burwells Corner, thence on a line of marked trees to a Stake corner on the old line, including One hundred Acre, Together with all and singular the members and all that appertains to the said land & premises belonging, or in any wise appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the land and premises to the said John Sanford his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Laurence Brasher do hereby bind myself, my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described land & premises to the said John Sanford against myself, my heirs and assigns & power all other persons claiming the same or any part thereof.
