grant bargain sell and release unto the said Vincent Harrison
all that tract or parcel of land containing ninety seven acres
or the same more or less, situated in Greenville District beginning on
Fountain of a line on a black oak, running E 21.35 to and oak,
thence S. 44^o 72 to a post oak, thence N. 21.35 to a post oak
N. a conditional line to a large hickory, thence to a white oak
thence to hickory, & thence to the beginning the sd land was gra-
nted, to Daniel Langford the 2nd day of October 1786 by his
Excellency William Moultrie together with allanna Saigu-
lar the right number heretofore, & appertenance, to the
said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentio-
ned unto the said Vincent Harrison his heirs and assigns forever
& I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators
to warrant and defend all and singular the sd premises
unto the said Vincent Harrison his heirs & assigns against my
Self & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my
hand and Seal this 26 day of January one thousand eight hundred
& fifteen & in the 39th year of American Independence Signed
