hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Isaac Forester of the
same State and Greenville district, and for the said sum have granted bar-
gained and sold and by these presents have granted bargained and sold
and released and conveyed unto the said Isaac Forester to him his heirs
Exec^{rs} Admors or Assigns One hundred and seventy acres of Land situate
and lying in Greenville district on the branches of Filders Creek, the Waters of
Enoree River beginning at red Oak standing on a road, then running N. 75 W.
25 chains to red Oak by fork of a branch, then South 44 chains to red Oak & 3 on
land surveyed for James Butterton, then with said land East 5 chains 32
links to post oak & then South 27 chains 50 links to a Stake, then S. 73 E. 40
Chains to Stake, then N. 2 E. 58 chains to Stake, then N. 60 W. 6 chain, 50 links
to Chermul on a road then with the road to the beginning, to include one
hundred and seventy acres of land, Together with all the premises & appur-
tinances thereto belonging, to the only proper use and behoof of him the
said Isaac Forester him his heirs Exec^{rs} Admors or Assigns for ever. And
the said James Wafford doth quit all claims to the said land and doth Warrant
and forever defend the said land from me my heirs Exec^{rs} Admors or Assigns &
