to me in hand paid by Street Thurston of the district of Greenville  
and State aforesaid hath granted bargained and sold, and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said Street Thurston fore Tracts or parcels of land adjoining  
each other, and being and lying in the district of Greenville  
and State aforesaid and on the waters of the Beaver dam Creek  
a Water of S<sup>t</sup>. Tiger river, and the waters of S<sup>t</sup>. Tiger river  
Containing two hundred and ninety nine acres more or less, &  
Bounded as followeth, VIZ, one part of a tract of land purchase of  
William Roe containing one hundred and sixty fore acres a  
bout thirty five acres of the purchase from Roe sold off to Carter  
Langley, bounded by lands of s<sup>ca</sup> Langley George & Jesse Titcomb Wil-  
liam Sturats Mellys and land granted to William Whaley, which  
s<sup>ca</sup> one hundred and sixty fore acres of land being part of a tract of  
two hundred and thirty nine acres granted to Obadiah Hooper & by  
the said Hooper conveyed to John Childress, and by him to Robert  
Childress and by him to William Roe, and by the said Roe to Robert  
Carter, as by the Records will more fully appear. Also the above  
described land part of it is taken out of a tract of six hundred &  
fourteen acres granted to John Childress and conveyed <sup>from him</sup> as before  
described. One other tract of land adjoining the above describe  
tract containing thirty three acres beginning on an Ash Corner on the  
North side of Clara Creek a Water of South Tiger river running N.
