 against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, and from

 William F. Turner of Greenville do hereby and in consideration of the
 Love & affection to my son William Turner of the district aforesaid hath
 given and granted and by these presents do fully give and grant unto
 the said William Turner a tract or plantation of land laying lying
 in the district aforesaid on the East side of Curtains Creek a branch
 of Saleda where he now lives beginning at a black Oak corner
 on the river Benjamin Turners line, along S. Turners line unto
 the corner on a black oak from thence along S. Turners line to his
 corner, from thence along said line to a Stake from thence along
 Brimmers line to the road and along the road unto a Pine Corner
 marked by sa Turner and Joseph Turner, from thence along a Con-
 ditional line marked by the two parties unto Armstrongs Creek at
 Black Oak Corner, thence down the said Creek unto the river, thence down
 the river to the beginning, containing one hundred acres, more or less
 and here conveyed to me: Together with all and singular the rights
 Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise appertaining: to have and to hold all & singular
 the premises before mentioned unto said Turner. And I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors or Administrators to warrant and defend
 the above mentioned premises unto the said William Turner his Heir for ever
 against myself my heirs, & against every person or persons whomsoever
 claiming or to claim the same lawfully or any part thereof
