State of South Carolina Greenville District, Agreeable to an act of assembly of the State aforesaid bearing date the twentieth day of December eight hundred & Benjamin Arnold one of the Justices of the Quorum being informed by William Arnold that he had an intention to emancipate, & set free a certain negroe woman named Amy, pursuant thereto I issued summons to five free holders who attended accordingly the said slave being present & after asking the said William Arnold the necessary questions, on oath prescribed by law, Do, give the following certificate, & we do hereby certify upon the examination on oath of William Arnold the owner of a certain slave named Amy thirty eight or nine years old about five feet high of yellow complexion, Satisfactory proof has been given to us that the said slave is not of bad character & is capable of gaining a livelihood by honest means, certified by us this tenth day of Feb^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & Seventeen.

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Nathan Waddell of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Huff - of the State & district aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Huff one certain tract or parcel of land, containing two hundred acres be the same more or less. Situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the East Side of Saluda river bounded West on Saluda River South on lands laid out for Jesse Duncan east on land held by Gideon Dalton north on land granted to James Nicholson Esq^r. & hath such shape and marks as are fairly designated by a plat annexed the original grant which will fully & at large appear reference
