The State of South Carolina Know all men by these Presents, that I Richard Lewis of the County of Rutherford and State of North Carolina: for and in consideration of the sum of thirty one dollars and fifty cents to me in hand paid by William Holcombe of the district of Greenville & State of South Carolina have granted bargained sold and released, & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Wm. Holcomb a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the district of Greenville on the water of South Pacolet River beginning on a poplar on the ancient Indian boundary line running thence N 44 chains to a Stake, thence S. 70 W. 15 chs to a black Oak on William McClain's line, thence S. 24 Eas't 9 chs 50 links to a White Oak, thence S. 6. W. 29 chs 50 links to a lightwood Stake, John Hickman's corner, thence East 6 chs to an ash on the old Mill house branch, thence down with the meanders of the branch to the beginning, containing forty two acres, more or less. Being part of a tract of land originally granted to Ann Saunders by Patent bearing date the fifteenth day of January 1801. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said William Holcombe his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Holcombe his heirs executors administrators or assigns against myself my heirs executors administrators or assigns, and against all & singular the claim of every other person or persons whom ⁴⁸ soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
