46 & 51, and in the additional Plan by M. Bee 13 & 15 in
the North West Square. Beginning at the Corner of said
Earles Lots, and runs S. 16° West 200 feet with said
Earles Lots to a Stake, thence N. 74° W. 58 ³/₄ feet to a
Stake, thence N. 16° E. 200 feet to a Stake, thence S 74°
E. fifty eight and three quarters feet to the beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
ing or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and
to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said
Geo. W. Earle his heirs and assigns forever. And I do
hereby bind myself my heirs executors & Administrators
to Warrant and for ever defend all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said George W. Earle
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and
against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
