This Indenture made and confirmed this twentieth of december in the year
 of our lord one thousand eight hundred and Six Martin Conner of the one
 part John Frammel of the other part, both of the State of South Carolina & Greenville
 District the said Martin Conner for and in consideration of the sum of one hun-
 -dred dollars to him in hand paid by John Frammel hereby I do acknowledge
 that I Martin Conner hath Bargained and sold & by these presents doth bargain
 and sell unto the said John Frammel a certain tract of land containing one
 hundred acres be the same more or less, lying in the district of Greenville on a creek
 called Buck Horn beginning on a tuckery running North to a Post oak corner,
 from thence running west to a black oak corner from thence down to ^{the} Head of
 a Branch which S^d Branch is a conditional line made by Page Puckitt & Tharis
 Puckitt his son, down S^d Branch to an old path from thence to the South line
 from thence an East course to the beginning corner hereby I do warrant this
 tract of land from my heirs and assigns forever unto John Frammel his
 heirs and assigns forever, Here I have to set my hand and affixed my seal
 the day and year above written, Sealed signed & delivered in the presence
