the same more or less, Together with all and singular the rights members
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the S^d premises belonging
in anywise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Henry Cannon his heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind my
self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and defend
and defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Henry Cannon
his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every person
whomsoever lawfully claiming the same any part thereof as witness
my hand and seal this 22nd ^{day of} March in the year of our Lord one
