South Carolina Greenville District; Shew all men by these presents that I Daniel White of the district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John King, I have this day granted bargained sold, & by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John King a tract or parcel of land lying in the district aforesaid on the waters of Saluda river & Reedy runs containing one Hundred acres, more or less, it Being part of a tract of land originally granted James Full bounding on lands of William Gorlette & James Bell beginning on a red oak running thence to a pine <sup>corner</sup> thence along the said line to a conditional corner on a post oak, thence to a conditional pine corner on Bells land, thence a straight line to a red oak, thence along the original line to the beginning Red oak, the above bounds to contain the land to be conveyed, Together with all and singular the rights and members hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John King his heirs & assigns or administrators, I do hereby bind myself my heirs and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John King his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
