Red oak being part of a tract originally granted to the said William Tisdale on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by his Excellency William Moultrie To have and to hold all the premises before mentioned Together with the Rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances therein to belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Damas his heirs or assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves as administrators to the estate of the said dec<sup>d</sup> with our successors so far as the said estate may enable us to warrant & defend the premises before described against ourselves our successors or the heirs to said estate & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this twelfth day of June in the Year of our Lord 1806 Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of Test.
