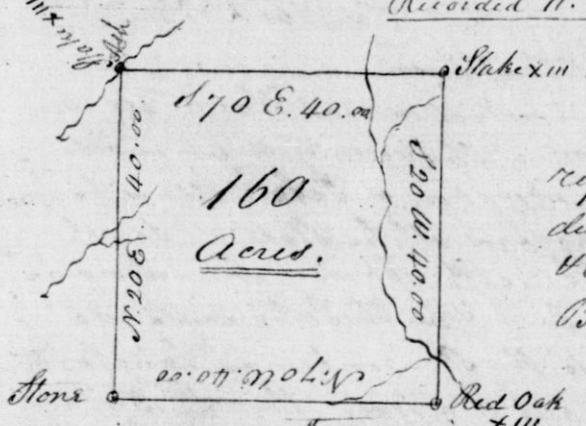


South Carolina Greenville District Personally Examined

 do grant Bargain sell & Release unto the said Benjamin Langford
 a tract of Land containing two Hundred & Eighteen Acres situate
 on a Branch of much Creek a fork of South Tyger river Greenville
 District having such marks boundaries & soundings as a plat for
 the same represents being granted to David Norrington beginning
 on a Chestnut thence S 15 W 27 650 to a post Oak thence S 40 W 17 1/2
 Black Oak thence S 10 W 28 10 to red Oak thence S 80 E 35 50 to a
 stake thence N 30 E 25 50 to stake thence N 20 W 30 40 to stake
 thence N 70 E 15 to stake thence N 62 W 30 to the beginning corner
 to have & to hold all & singular the Rights Members Appurtenan-
 ments & appertainments to said Land Belonging or in any
 wise appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Langford his heirs &
 assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
 administrators to Warrant & forever Defend all and singular
 the premises unto the said Benjamin Langford his heirs &
 assigns against myself & my heirs & against Every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to Claim or in any part there-
 of in Witness Whereof I have set my hand and seal this nineteenth
 day of October Eighteen hundred & first in the twentieth year
 of American Independance signed sealed & Delivered in presence
