Benj. Griffith Esquire: Situate lying and Being in the  
District of Greerelle and Stoke aforesaid on the waters of  
Redy More and Richland Creek on the North East side & side  
water being originally granted in five different Grants to  
a grant to Sadoc Brister for one hundred Acres dated the 1<sup>st</sup>  
of March 1786 one other grant to said Brister for one hundred  
and sixty acres dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of August 1786 one other grant to  
said Brister for two hundred and forty four acres dated  
the 5<sup>th</sup> of November 1792 a grant to Daniel Wilbanks for  
one hundred and thirty eight acres dated 1<sup>st</sup> of December  
1794 and Conveyed from said Wilbanks to said Brister  
and a grant to Archibald Hawker dated in 1798 post  
at which to wit one hundred and thirty six acres was Con-  
veyed from said Hawker to said Flimming the 20<sup>th</sup> day of  
January 1818 Boundded on the S<sup>o</sup> W. by Iowmatt Shakes and  
said Greens land on the West by said Greens land on the north  
by John Watsons land on the North East by said Greens and  
Hillmans land and on the East by Fowlers and Andrewwoods  
Land Beginning on a Stake corner adjoining Stoke land running  
thence S<sup>o</sup> 65 W. 27 ch. 50 links to a Red Oak, thence N. 30 W. 90 chains  
to a Pine stump thence N. 60 E. 28 ch to a Black Oak thence N.  
75 E. 20 ch. to a Stake thence S<sup>o</sup> 68 W. 18 ch to a Stake thence North  
one chain to a Stake, thence N. 30 E. 45 ch to a Stake thence N. 34  
W. 38.50 to a Black Oak thence N. 65 E. 15 ch to a Dogwood  
thence S. 30 E. 19 ch to a Black Oak thence S<sup>o</sup> 10 E. 22.75 to a Dogwood  
by a dead White Oak thence S. 15 W. 20 ch. 75 links to a pine by a  
dead Post Oak thence S. 17 E. 58 ch. to a pine thence S. 80 E. 34 ch.  
to a Hickory thence S. 65 W. 62 ch. 75 links to a Black Oak thence  
N. 32 W. 1.25 to the begining together with all and singular the  
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining to  
have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns for ever. and  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators  
to warrant and forswear defend all and singular the  
premises before mentioned (including the Cotton Machine  
& Scro) unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns  
against myself and my Heirs claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof. in witness whereof I have hereunto set  
my Hand & Seal this Twenty first day of January in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen  
and in the forty second year of the American Independence
