Ninth day of February in the year of one thousand eight
hundred & sixteen for and in consideration of one hundred
and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by William
Cannady of the State and District aforesaid have
Granted bargained and sold unto the said Cannady
a certain tract or parcel of land containing one
Hundred & Eighty five acres be the same more or less
in the Description aforesaid and bounded as followeth
beginning at a post oak thence to a pine thence to a
Walnut thence to a post oak thence to a pine on the
Bank of the River on Goodlets line thence running S 53
E east North corners old line on Silver's Branch to a
stake then up said branch to a black oak a corner of
Bruce's land thence with Bruce's line to a pine thence
to a Black oak thence to a Post oak on Maples line thence
to a pine thence to the Beginning which said tract or
parcel of land containing Eighty four acres more or
less to gether with all and singular the Rets members
Hereditaments appurtenances ther unto belonging or in
any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned and sold unto
the said William Cannady his heirs and assigns forever
in few simple I do bind my self my heirs executors ad
trustees to warrant and forever defend unto the said
William Cannady his heirs and assigns and against
my self and my heirs and every other person what
soever from setting up any lawful claim to the same
or any part thereof in witness whereof I have set my
hand seal the day and date above written
