




Sum of Six Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by
Charles Maxwell of the State and District aforesaid
the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Grant
ed Bargained and sold and by these Presents do
Grant Bargain and sell unto the said Charles Maxwell
a certain tract of Land containing two Hundred ac
res more or less situate Laying and being in Greenville
District & State aforesaid on Branches of the Gods in
Grove Creek Waters of Saluda River, it being a tract
of Land originally Granted to John Maxwell Deceased
Beginning at a Stake & Running thence N 42 E. 44th 73
links to a Stake & thence N 48 W 44th 73 links to
P Oak Ct. thence S. 42. W. 44th 73 links to a Stake &
thence S 48. E. 44th 73 links to the Beginning Ct. as
will more fully appear by the Original plat to
have and to hold the before mentioned Premises
