Stokes of Spartanburgh District have Granted Bargained sold &
-Released and by these presents do grant and sell bargain and
-Release unto the said Jonathan Stokes a Tract or parcel of Land lay-
-ing and being in the District of Greenville aforesaid on both sides
of the Beaver Dam Creek of Tygar Beginning at Pysimmor &
-Grove on the N^o side of the Creek near the mouth of my Mill house
branch & running thence N. 14 W. 45 Ch^o to a Chestnut William
Holcombs corner thence with his line S. 57. W. 8 Ch^o 50 L^o to a
-poplar Holcombs & Harris' corner near a Branch thence
with the meanders of the branch a S. W. direction & Harris' line
a bout 30 Ch^o to a Hickory thence S. 14 E. 9 Ch^o 50 L^o to a Chestnut
thence S. 74 W. with Harris' line 6 Ch^o 50 L^o to a Black Gum
-crossing the creek thence S. 70. W. 27 Ch^o to a Sm^o 300 Oak
-leaf's line Harris' S. corner thence S. 29 Ch^o to a Blk. Oak the
-ence E. 72 Ch^o 50 L^o to a White Oak thence N. 74 Ch^o 50 L^o to
an Ash on the S. bank of the Creek below my Grist Mill and
