


N<sup>o</sup> 44 ch 72 1/2 to the beginning corner with reference to the original plat which will make it more fully appear, also one other tract or parcel of land containing thirty six acres being part of two tracts of land one granted to John Thomas the other to Joseph Shannon & adjoining the above described land & bounded as follows beginning on a Sweet gum corner on the bank of South Tiger river & running from thence N: 55 E: 5 ch. to a red oak corner thence N: 25 ch to a Post Oak corner thence W: 15 ch to a hickory corner thence S: 12 W: 13 ch 75 1/2 to a maple in the edge of a swamp thence following the meanders of the swamp to an ash corner on the bank of the river thence down the meanders of the river to the beginning corner together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said David Masteller his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said David Masteller his heirs & assigns against my self & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this twenty second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty eight & in the forty second year of the independence of the United States of America signed sealed & delivered in presence of
