to me in hand paid by Ezekiel Henderson of Greenville
District & State aforesaid have Granted Bargained & Sold &
by these presents do grant Bargain Sell & Release unto
the said Ezekiel Henderson one Hundred & Twenty acres
of Land lying in Greenville D. on the waters of Reedy
River joining the lands Wherupon the said Henderson now
lives being part of a tract of one Hundred & Sixty one
Acres Granted on the first day of July one Thousand Seven
Hundred & ninety three by his Excellency Edward Rutledge
to Wilson Nabby to have & to hold the aforesaid Tract of
Land with & every the premises & appurtenances there-
-unto belonging unto the said Ezekiel Henderson his heirs
& assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs
Executors & administrators unto the said Ezekiel
Henderson his heirs Executors & administrators to
Warrant & forever defend the aforesaid tract of land &
all the appurtenances thereto belonging from all
person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same
or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this 2^d day of January 1818
