 Holcombe of the District of Greenville & State of South Carolina &
 Theron Earle of the district of Spartanburg & State of South Carolina
 have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant
 bargain sell & release unto the s^d William Holcombe & Theron Earle
 all & singular the two Tracts or Parcels of land herein after Describ-
 ed Situate in District of Greenville on The Waters of South
 Pacolati one adjoining thereto on the North Side beginning at a rag-
 wood on the bank of the River about forty Poles below the Mill &
 running thence nearly a West Course with the present fence & by
 the bottom of the Old field till it strikes a line running from a black
 Oak on Bates old line thence N^o 31^o E^o 50^o W^o to some black Oak saplings
 on Moses Whites Old line thence N^o 72^o East with his line to a
 maple on the bank of the Creek thence up the Meanders of the Creek to a
 small white Oak thence N^o 70^o East 10^o E^o to a post Oak thence N^o 75^o
 West 7^o E^o 50^o W^o to a post Oak thence East 19^o E^o 50^o W^o to an Ash
 on the Old Still house branch thence down the Meanders of the said
 branch to an Ash on the South side of the River. Resces beginning com-
 -ore thence up the Meanders of the River to the Beginning containing
 Eighty Acres more or less the other adjoining the Above containing one
 Hundred acres more or less beginning at the above mentioned black
 Oak saplings & running a West Course with Moses Whites Old line
 to his Corner thence with Willey & Browns Old line to John Whittens
 line thence with his line to Robert Goodmans Old line thence with
 his line to John Bates Old line thence with his line to the first Men-
 -tioned black Oak his corner & thence N^o to the beginning containing
 in the whole one hundred & Eighty Acres More or less Conveyed from
