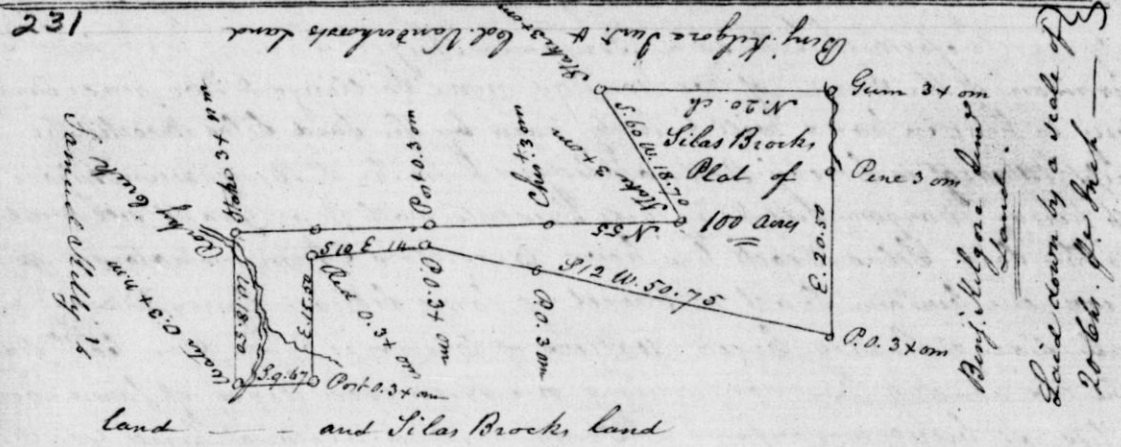

 The State of South Carolina Know all Men by these presents that I Joseph King of Greenville district & State aforesaid for & in Consideration of the sum of one Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Theron Earle of Spartanburg District & State aforesaid Have Granted bargained sold & Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Theron Earle all that Tract or parcel of Land situate in the district of Greenville on both sides of Mill Creek Waters of S^c Jacolet River beginning at a Pine running thence N: 40. W: to a Red Oak thence S: 50 W: 27 chains to a Chesnut stake thence at 40 E. to a small pine Embryo corner to the beginning containing one hundred Acres more or less including the Dwelling house and most of the Plantation Together with all & singular the rights now & here hereunto appertaining to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have I do hold all & singular the premises afo. unto the said Theron Earle his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & Administrators to Warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Theron Earle his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs executors Administrators or assigns against all & singular the claim of every other person or persons Whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & Seal this Sixteenth day of June one Thousand Eight hundred & Eighteen Signed Sealed & Acknowledged in presence of
