 sold & Relied & by these presents do Grant Bargain sell Release  
 & convey unto John Marshall a certain tract of Land containing one  
 hundred & twenty Acres More or Less Situate on the North Side of the  
 South fork of Galena River Gr. Det. Beginning on Joseph Henders Corners  
 Spruce pine on the Du River at the Mouth of the Roaring Branch  
 from thence a long hard pine line to his corner White Oak from  
 thence a Long a Line of Marked Trees Nearly a North East Course  
 to the Line of said Blyth Grant from thence a long one of D. Grants  
 to his markers Line from thence a long hickories Line to the River  
 from thence up the Du River to the beginning To have & to hold  
 all and singular the Right Members hereditaments & Appurtenances  
 unto the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have  
 & to hold all & singular the Granted premises as before mentioned  
 unto John Marshall his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind  
 Myself My heirs Executors & Administrators & assigns to Warrant and  
 and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the & John  
 Marshall his heirs & assigns against my self My heirs & assigns and
