

bargain sell release confirm & convey unto the said Jesse Davis all
that plantation tract or parcel of land containing fifty acres the
same more or less Situate lying & being in the state & district aforesaid
lying on the south side of a small creek the waters of south Tiger & said
Creek the line between Nathaniel Jackson, Geo. Russell & the said Jesse Davis
himself, beginning on the south side of D. Creek on a poplar running
thence S. twenty five degrees East thirty two chains to a small post oak
thence N. seventy eight degrees East seventeen chains to a rock, near a branch
Creek thence down the several meanders of the D. Creek to where it empties in the
a poplar Stake, being a part of a tract of land granted to Ruben Barret
by patent bearing date the third of October one thousand seven hundred
& eighty five, Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold
all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jesse Davis
his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and defend all & singular
the said premises unto the said Jesse Davis his heirs & assigns forever
against myself my heirs & against every other person or persons
whatsour claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof. In Witness
