Alexander of the one part & the of the presbyterian congregation of  
Fair view of the other part. Witness that the aforesaid John Alexan-  
-der for the Inconsideration of the sum of Ten dollars in hand  
paid by the afores<sup>d</sup> trustees, the receipt is hereby acknowledged  
hath granted bargained sold released conveyed & confirmed  
unto the said trustees, and their successors in office all that parcel  
or tract of land around Fair view Meeting house for the only  
proper use of the afores<sup>d</sup> presbyterian congregation to containe  
2 acres around the afores<sup>d</sup> Meeting house the house to be in the  
Center. Together with all and singular the houses, woods, waters,  
ways, privileges, and appurtenances, therunto belonging to have &  
to hold for the only proper use of the afores<sup>d</sup> presbyterian congre-  
-gation in trust that they will build a house for the worship  
of All mighty God & for that and no other purpose and the afores<sup>d</sup>  
John Alexander doth by these presents, forre warrant and  
defend from myself my heirs, & no other person as Witness where  
of I have hereunto set my hand and seal the year & date above  
written signed in the presence of us -

State of South Carolina Greenville district Know all men by these  
present, that I John Duncan of the state and district aforesaid for an  
in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by  
Samuel Duncan of s<sup>d</sup> district & state aforesaid have granted bargained  
and sold released unto the s<sup>d</sup> Samuel Duncan a certain tract or parcel  
of land containing fifty acres be it the same more or less lying on the  
waters of Rudy Run it being part of a tract of land granted to Young  
Puffin bearing date the first of December 1794 bounded as follows  
beginning at a corner maple on Joseph Batsons line thence said  
Batsons line to the old original line to a corner stake thence along  
original to a corner hickory thence s<sup>d</sup> line to a corner hickory by  
lands unknown thence along s<sup>d</sup> line N 17<sup>o</sup> 17<sup>o</sup> 00 to a corner hickory
