 & released by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the S<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup>  
 Tranum all that plantation or tract of land containing twenty  
 five acres (Be the same more or less) Situate in the said district lying  
 on Horse creek beginning on a hickory 3<sup>x</sup> on a branch thence N 30° W  
 19.75. to a hickory 3<sup>x</sup> bounding on Benjamin Arnold, line thence  
 N 60 E 38.50 to a red oak 3<sup>x</sup> bounding on the S<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Tranum thence  
 S 30 E 25 to a stake 3<sup>x</sup> bounding on David Tranum thence S 44 W 32.  
 25. to a sweet Gum 3<sup>x</sup> near horse creek bounding on Benj<sup>a</sup> Arnold  
 thence down the meanders of S<sup>r</sup> Creek to the mouth of a branch  
 thence up the branch to the beginning Reserving 50 links on each side  
 of Horse Creek for the use of Benj<sup>a</sup> Arnold together with all & sing-  
 ular the rights, members, boundaries, & appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have  
 & to hold all and singular the premises by me mentioned unto the  
 Said W<sup>m</sup> Tranum his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my-  
 self my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & defend all & sing-  
 ular the s<sup>r</sup> premises unto the S<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Tranum his heirs & assigns  
 against my self & my heirs & against every other person whomsoever  
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
 Witness my hand & Seal this twenty fifth day of August in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eighteen in the forty third  
 year of the Independence of the United States of America. Signed Sealed  
 and delivered in the presence of - {
