H. Joyce his heirs Exors Adms^r & assigns free & clear of all incumbrances & from & against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsover I the said John Wood do bind myself to warrant & defend the above named premises unto the s^d J. H. Joyce In Witness whereof I the s^d J. Wood have unto set my hand & seal this the 17th day of July 1816. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of
