that I Vardry M<sup>rs</sup> Be of Lincoln County and State of North  
Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred  
and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Doctor John Robinson  
of the district of Greenville and State of South Carolina, have  
granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Robinson  
a certain Lot of land, situate lying and being in the village  
at Greenville Courthouse in the State of South Carolina  
known and distinguished in the Plan of the said Village  
by the number twelve (N<sup>o</sup>: 12) in the North West square of  
the said Village, containing two hundred feet front on  
Avenue Street, and one hundred and thirteen and one third  
feet on Laurens Street; Beginning at a Stake Corner on  
Avenue Street, and running on the same with a row of Syc-  
amores two hundred feet to a Stake Corner; the course  
North twenty four degrees West - Thence north sixteen  
degrees East one hundred and thirteen and one third  
feet to a Stake (Corner to Lot N<sup>o</sup>: 14) thence South twenty four  
degrees <sup>169</sup> East, two hundred feet to a Stake on Laurens Street,  
thence with the same South sixteen degrees West one hundred  
and thirteen, & one third feet to the beginning; as may appear
